HKSS – John Aitchison Prize in Statistics

Applications are now being sought for the HKSS-John Aitchison Prize in Statistics, 2023.

The Prize was established in 2022 by the Hong Kong Statistical Society (HKSS), to honour the distinguished career and contributions of Professor John Aitchison (1926-2016), Chair Professor of Statistics at the University of Hong Kong between 1976 and 1989 and founder and first President of the HKSS.

The objective of the Prize is to reward excellence in PhD research, as demonstrated by a research paper, in Statistics or a closely related discipline.

The Prize is awarded once a year, with its value currently being HK\$12,000. Normally, there shall be only one award made every year, but the Adjudication Panel may recommend multiple awards to be made with the award amount to be shared by the awardees.

Conditions of Entry:

- The Prize is open to those who have had full-time student status for a PhD degree in Statistics or a closely related discipline at a Hong Kong university* anytime within the past two years before the closing date for applications.
- The applicant must be a member of the HKSS on the date of the application.

* A Hong Kong university is defined as a public or private tertiary education institution located in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China. This definition excludes tertiary institutions located in other parts of the world that carry the name Hong Kong in their titles.

Applications should be submitted by **email** to **hkss.japrize.submission@gmail.com** by **31 October 2022 (Monday)**. [Please mark "Submission of paper for 2023 HKSS-John Aitchison Prize in Statistics" as the subject of the email], and must include

- A formal letter of application
- A research paper (either already published in an academic journal or unpublished work) written by the applicant. Co-authored papers are allowed. However, the applicant must clearly state his/her contributions in the paper. The submitted paper must be formatted with 1.5 line spacing and should not exceed 30 A4 pages. If more space is needed, additional material (such as more elaborate technical details or simulation results) may be included as Supplementary Material.
- A CV of the applicant
- A letter of support by the applicant's PhD supervisor

The Adjudication Panel for the 2023 Award comprises Professor Wai Keung Li (Chairman) of the Education University of Hong Kong, Professor Ngai Hang Chan of City University of Hong Kong, and Professor Ian McKeague of Columbia University.

The award winner will be informed via email and the winner announcement will be posted on the websites of *Statistica Sinica* and the HKSS (<https://www.hkss.org.hk/index.php/japrize>) by around April 2023. The winner may be invited to give a presentation of his/her work at an award presentation ceremony.
